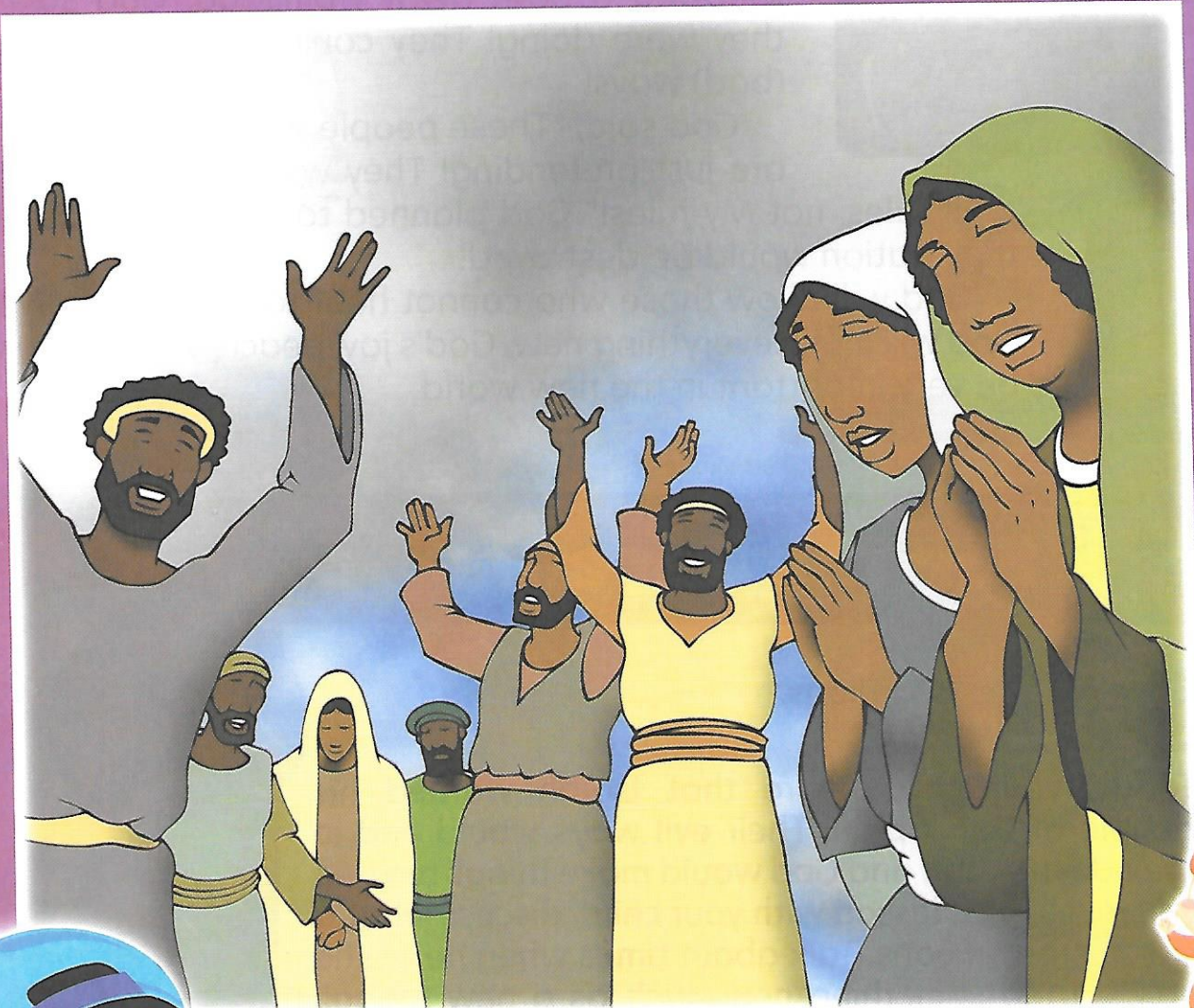

# A New Future

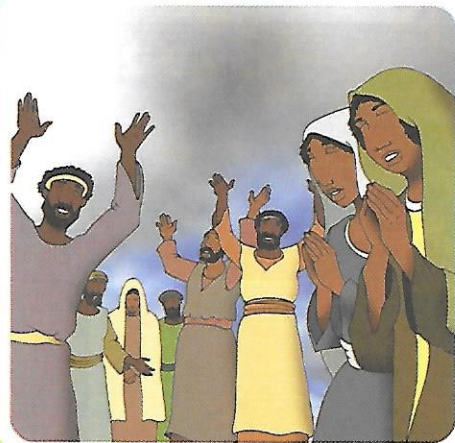


## Key Verse

## A New Future

(Isaiah 29:13-24)

Isaiah told his people that God wanted them to stop wandering away. These people had followed a path away from God. God saw all they were doing! They could not hide their evil (bad) ways!

God said, "These people worship Me, but they are just pretending! They worship Me by follow their rules, not My rules!" God planned to stop all of this and their nation would be destroyed!

God will allow those who cannot hear to hear God's Word. God will make everything new. God's joy, peace, and justice will be very important in the new world.

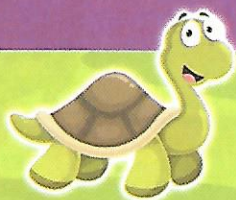

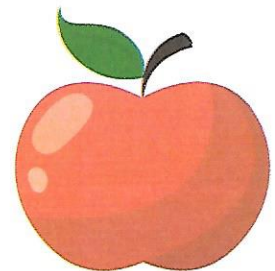
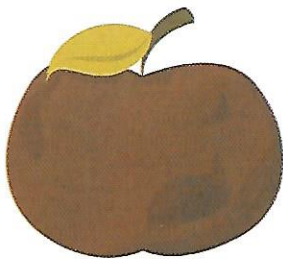
