

Together We Stand


Lesson Scriptures: **Mark 4:26-32; Ephesians 4:4-6**



Key Verses

Just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. (Romans 12:4-5)





Together We Stand

(Mark 4:26-32; Ephesians 4:4-6)

Jesus taught that the kingdom of God is like a seed that is planted. The planter does not see the seed growing. But at the right time, the plant's stalk, head, and kernels appear. When the grain is ripe, the planter *harvests* (gathers) the crops.

- Jesus said the kingdom of God is also like a tiny mustard seed.
- When the tiny seed is planted, it grows into the largest of all plants where birds live.
- We are one big family. When we stand together, we accomplish (do) a lot for God's kingdom. We share the same hope and believe in one Lord, one faith, and one baptism.




