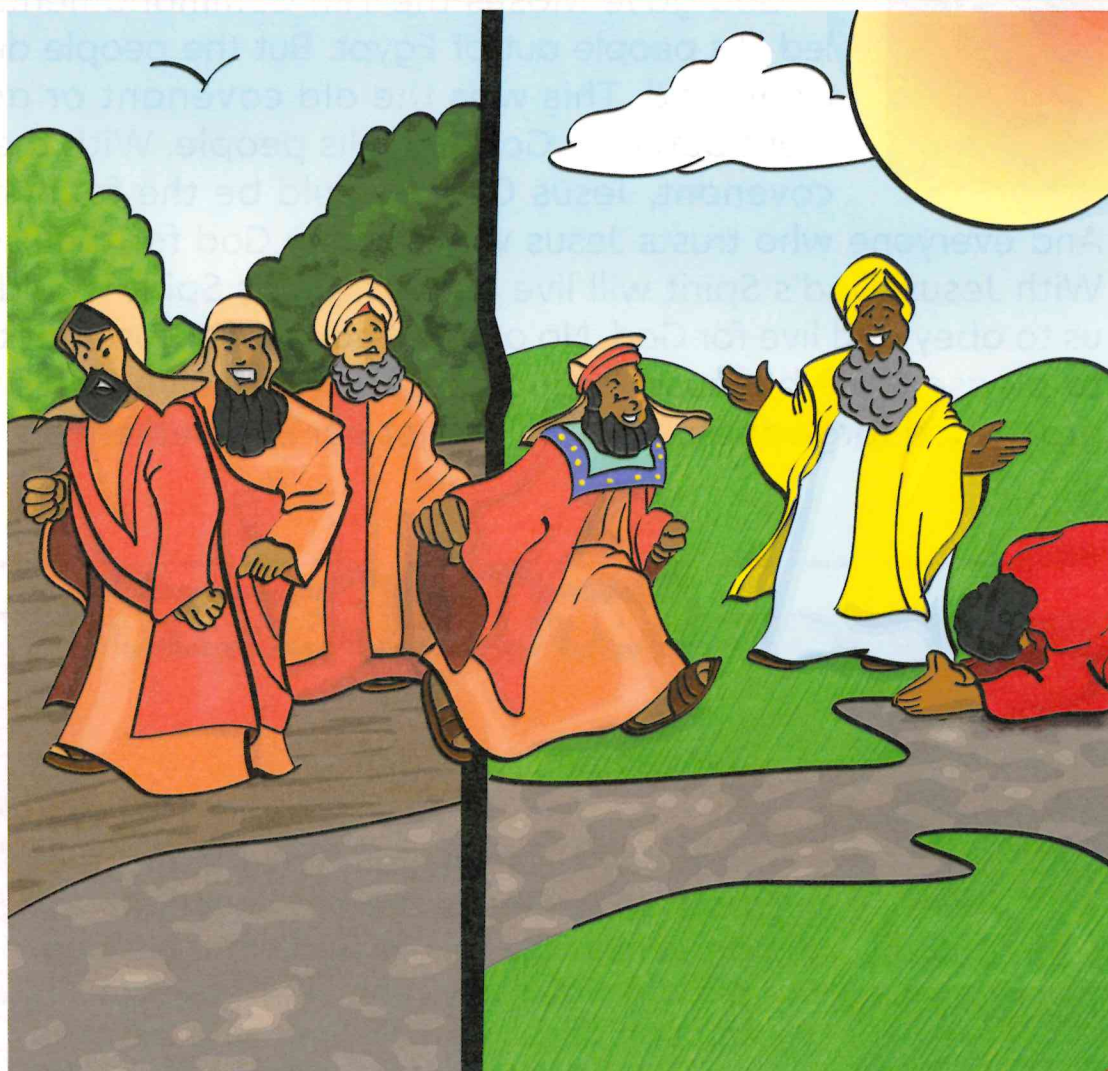


You Have No Excuse!

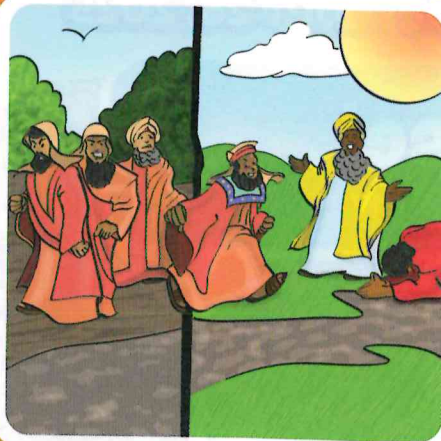
Lesson Scriptures: **Jeremiah 31:29-34; John 1:17**



Key Verse

[The Lord declared,] "I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people." (Jeremiah 31:33b)





You Have No Excuse!

(Jeremiah 31:29-34; John 1:17)

God gave Moses the Ten Commandments and led His people out of Egypt. But the people did not obey God. This was the old covenant or agreement between God and His people. With the new covenant, Jesus Christ would be the foundation.

And everyone who trusts Jesus would know God for themselves. With Jesus, God's Spirit will live with us. God's Spirit would lead us to obey and live for God. No one will have an excuse not to live to please God—because through Jesus, we receive God's truth, grace, and forgiveness. God will forget our disobedience.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

In today's lesson, your child heard that God gave Moses the old covenant—an agreement to follow God—but the people did not obey. The new covenant is through Christ for everyone who believes.
