

Lesson Scripture: John 15:4-17


Bearing Fruit by **Loving Others**




Jesus said, "I am the vine. You (believers) are My branches. Everyone who follows Me produces fruit (or does godly things). A cut branch will be gathered into a pile and burned. Those who desire to follow Me can ask for anything and it will be granted. My disciples produce fruit that brings honor to My Father.

"I love you like the Father loves Me. When you obey Me, you love Me. I obey My Father and am loved by Him. I told you this so that you will be filled with joy. I command you to love others as I love you. You show the areatest love by being willing to give up your life for your friends. You are My friends. I don't call you servants. As My friends, I have shared everything with you that the Father told Me. I chose you

> to produce fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask for in My name. I command you to love each other."
