


Fairness and Equality


Lesson Scriptures: Acts 10:9-15, 30-35; Galatians 3:28-29

God told Peter to eat, but Peter said, "No, I have never eaten meat from these unclean animals!"


God said, "Do not call anything unclean that I have made."
